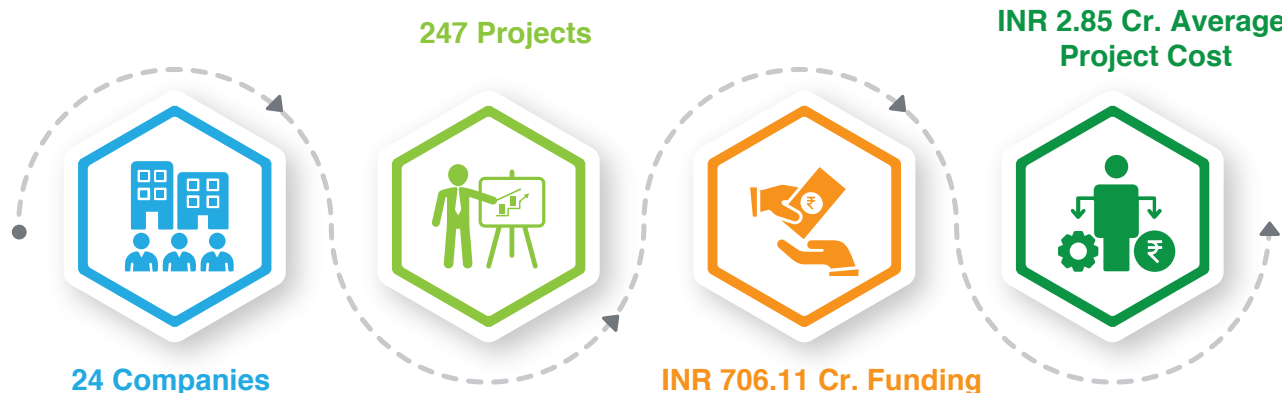


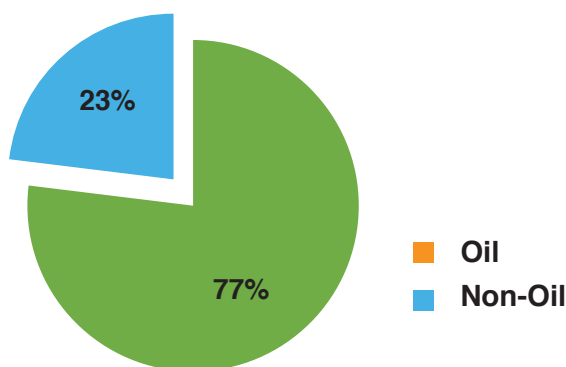
CSR Projects in Education by Oil, Lubricants & Petroleum Industry (FY2019)

Understanding how Oil, Lubricants & Petroleum companies contribute to the education sector through CSR

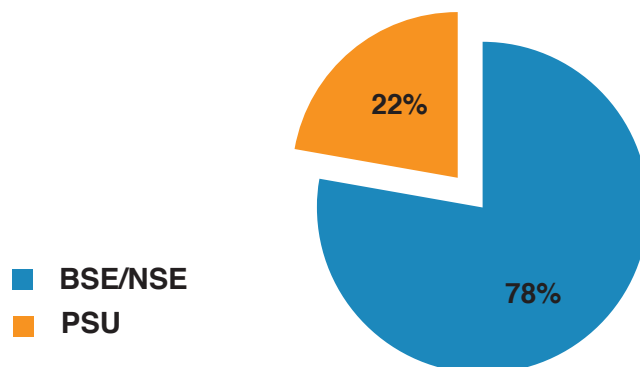

Oil vs. Non-Oil contribution to education through CSR

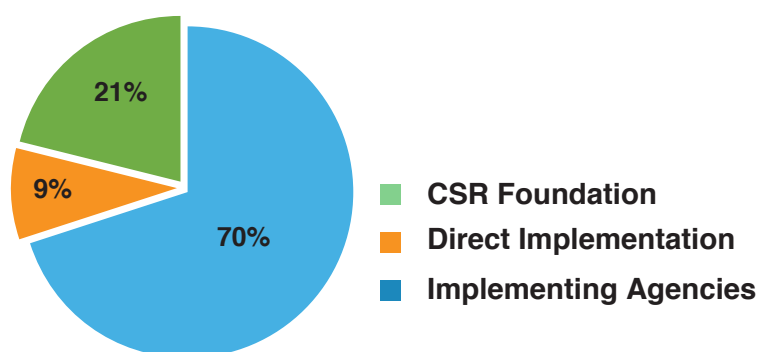


CSR Contribution by different types of companies to Educational project (Funding)



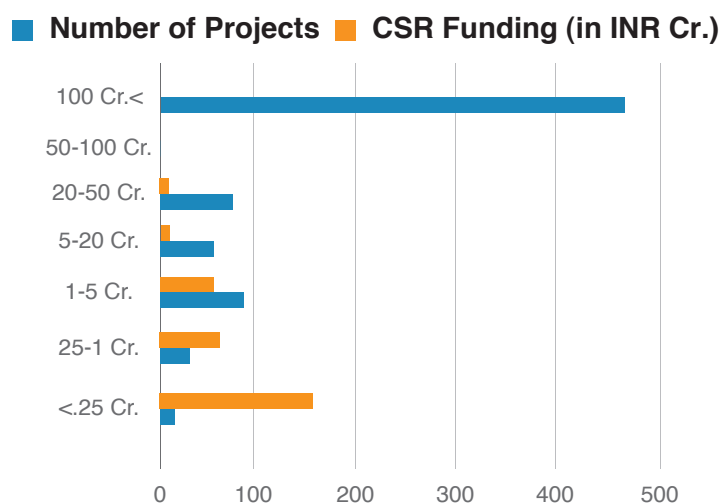
BSE/NSE listed companies comprise of the largest share in terms of both funding and number of projects in education.

CSR Project Implementation Mode



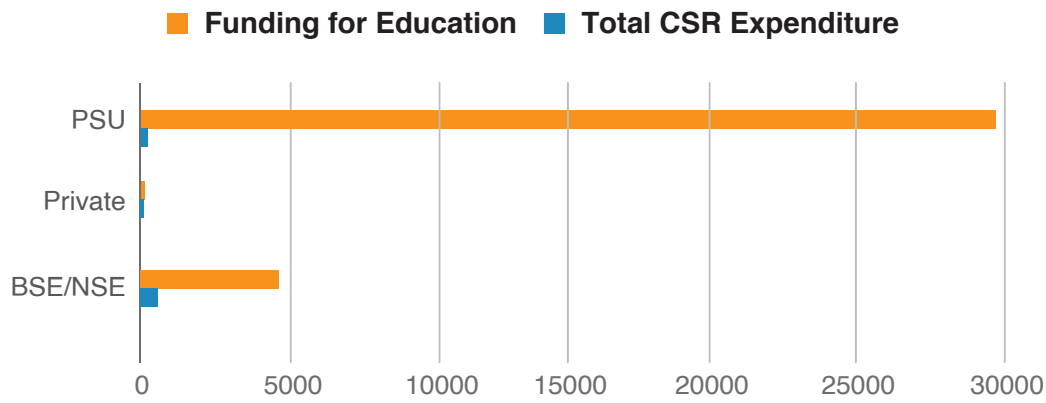
Implementing agencies lead CSR project execution in education sector

Budget range CSR projects in education



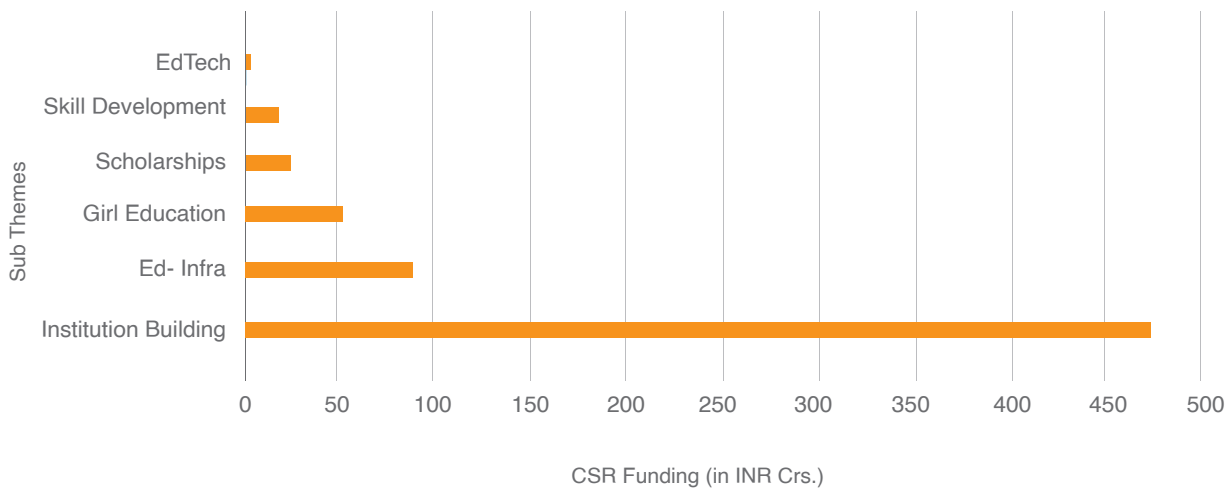
Most of the projects lie within the budget below INR 5 Cr
