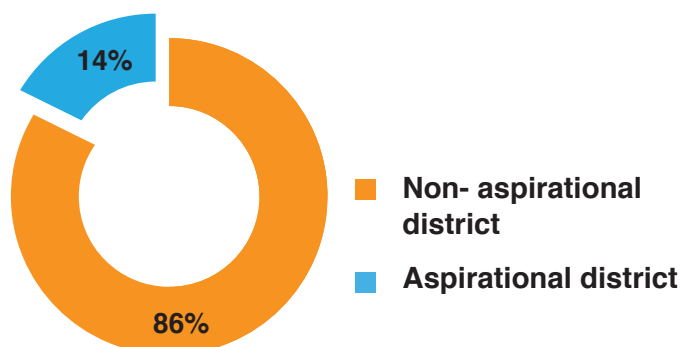

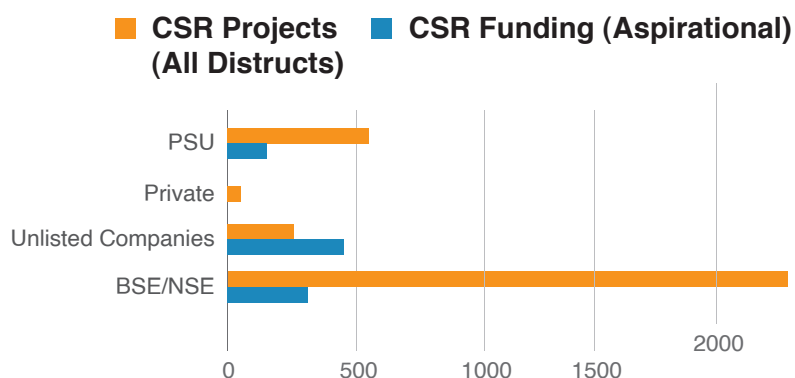

## Share of CSR Funding towards Aspirational Districts



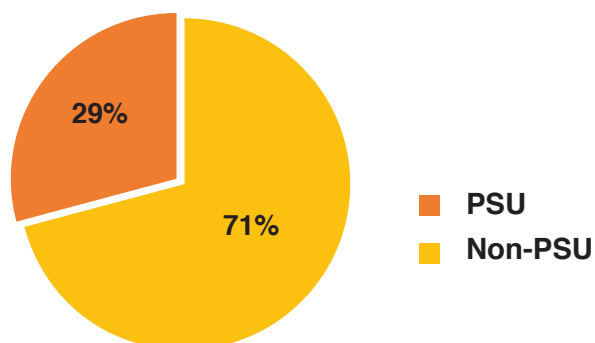
Only 14% of the total funding is dedicated towards the projects in aspirational districts.

## Company wise share in contribution to funding Aspirational Districts



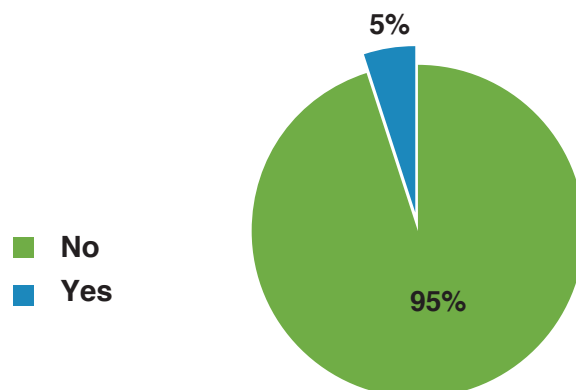

## PSU vs. Non-PSU funding (Aspirational Districts)



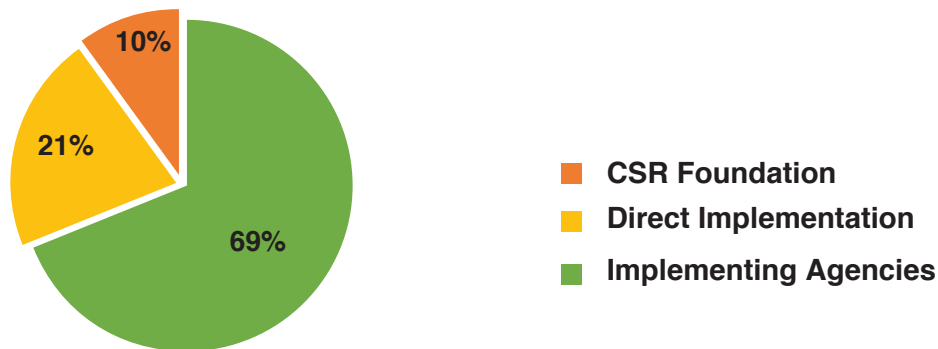
PSUs contribute 1/4th of their total CSR funding to educational projects in aspirational districts, holding 29% share in the total
