


Share of CSR Funding towards Aspirational Districts

Non- aspirational district Aspirational district


Only 14% of the total funding is dedicated towards the projects in aspirational districts.

PSU vs. Non-PSU funding (Aspirational Districts)




PSUs contribute 1/4th of their total CSR funding to educational projects in aspirational districts, holding 29% share in the total

Company wise share in contribution to funding Aspirational Districts





Project Implementation Mode in Aspirational Districts


