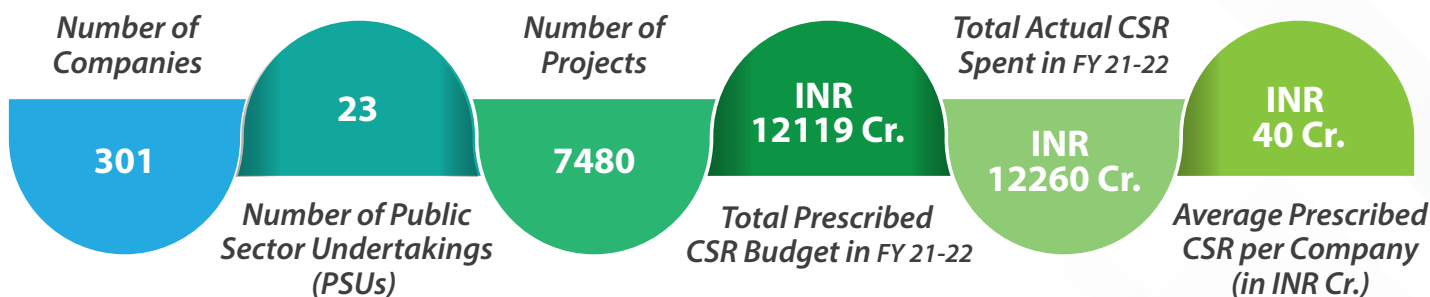

## About the Report

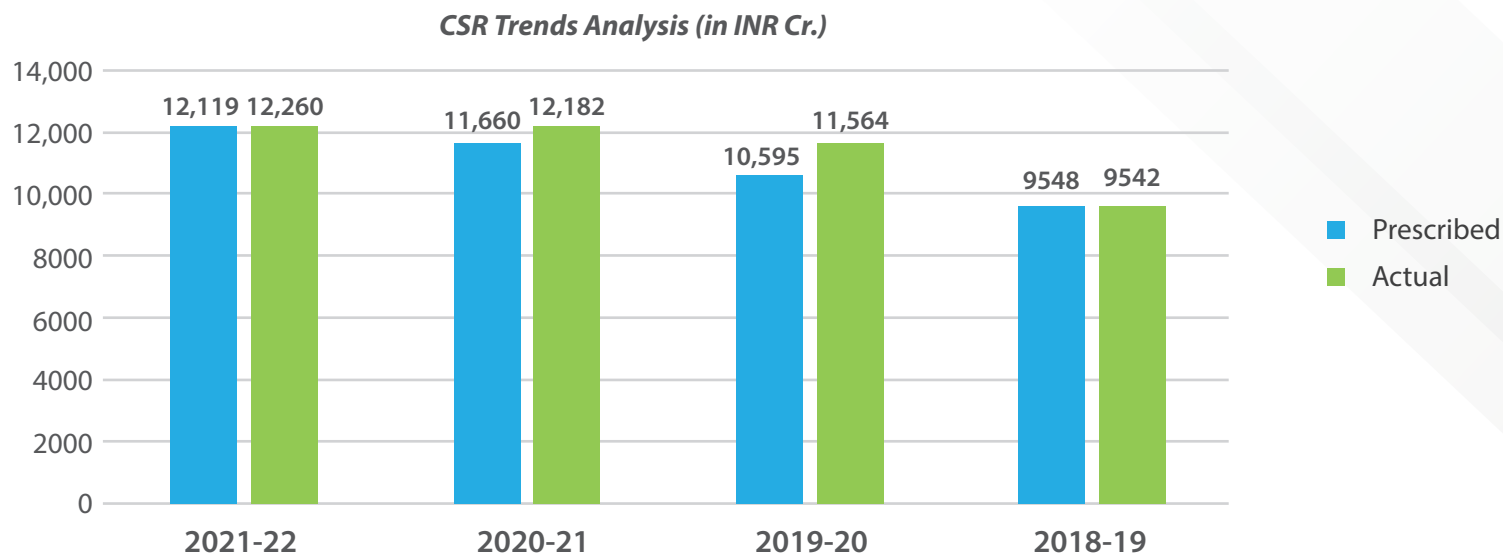

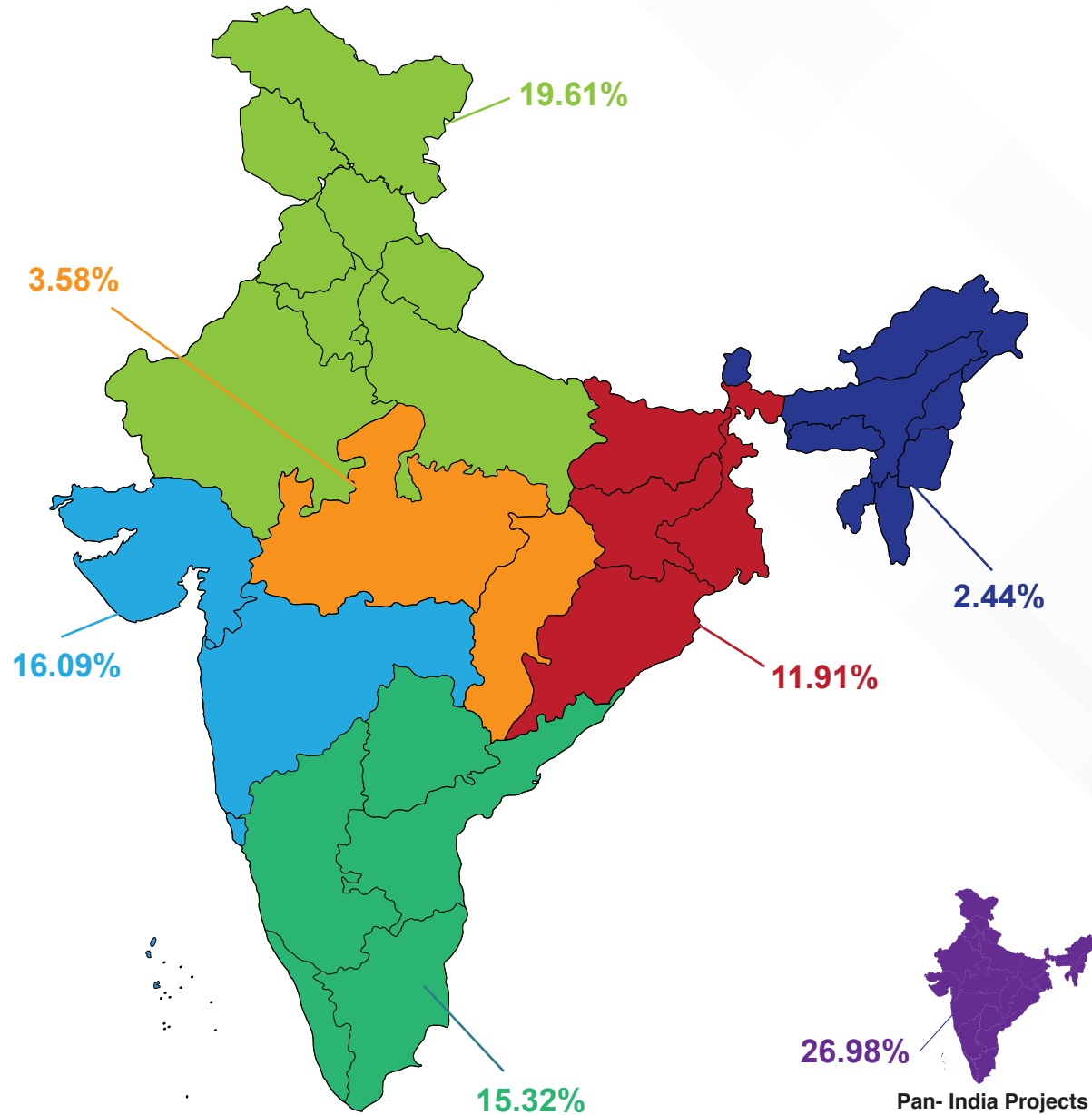

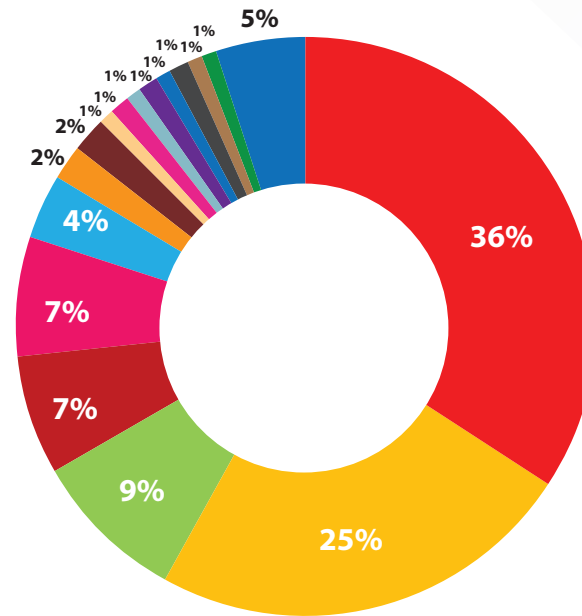
## Regional Distribution of CSR Fund

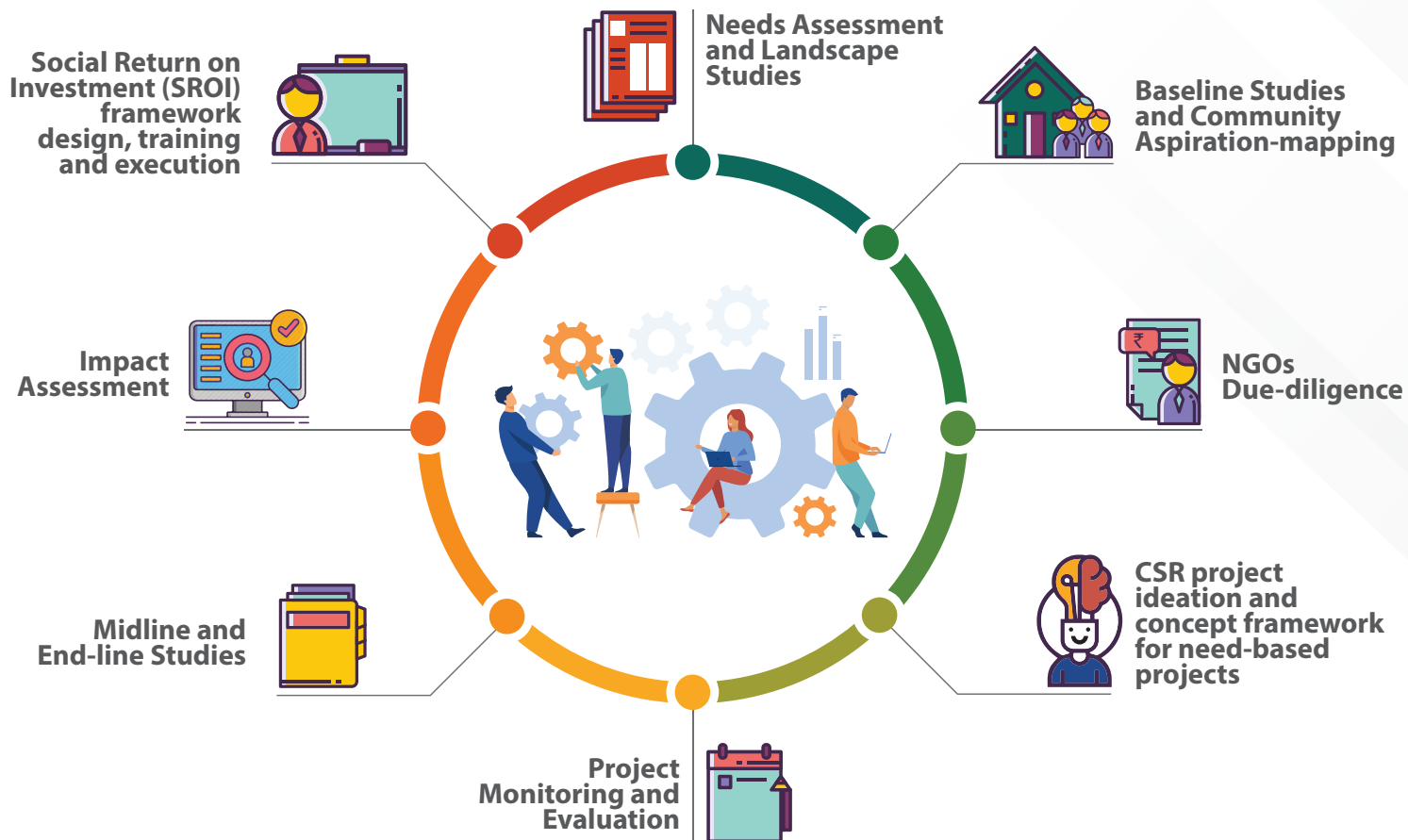
